**Marlborough, MA** – On Thursday, April 2nd from 6:30 – 8:30 pm, the Boys & Girls Clubs of MetroWest will host the 7th Annual Teen Job Fair at the Pleasant Street Clubhouse, 169 Pleasant Street, in Marlborough in collaboration with the Metro SouthWest Regional Employment Board. The event will feature local companies accepting applications to fill both full-time and part-time positions. This is a fantastic opportunity for teens looking for a summer, weekend or after school jobs to network with local businesses looking to hire the youth in our communities. Food and beverages will be provided for all participants, and St. Mary's Credit Union will be hosting a resume and interviewing skill session for participating teens, as well. Teens ages 16 and up from the local communities are able to participate in the evening.

Last year, the Teen Job Fair attracted almost 200 teens from Marlborough and Hudson looking to fill open positions for a diverse group of over 20 companies including banks, Best Buy, Starbucks and Dairy Queen. The teens are also always looking forward to interviewing for positions open here at the Boys & Girls Clubs of MetroWest as counselors for our summer programs. The Teen Job Fair is another program aligned with our overall mission to enhance the development of our teens and to prepare them to be responsible and productive members of our communities.
