8th ANNUAL TEEN JOB FAIR TO BENEFIT LOCAL COMMUNITIES
Fair To Help Driven Young Adults Gain Quality Experience & Fill Local Positions

Marlborough, MA – On Thursday, April 8th from 6:30 – 8:30 pm, the Boys & Girls Clubs of MetroWest will host the 8th Annual Teen Job Fair at the Pleasant Street Clubhouse, 169 Pleasant Street, in Marlborough in collaboration with the Metro SouthWest Regional Employment Board. The event will feature local companies accepting applications to fill both full-time and part-time positions. This is a fantastic opportunity for young adults ages 16 and up looking for full or part-time summer, weekend or after school jobs to network with local businesses looking to hire in the local communities.

Last year, the Teen Job Fair attracted almost 250 young adults ages 16-21 from Marlborough, Hudson, Southborough, Northborough, Framingham, Sudbury and surrounding communities looking to fill open positions for a diverse group of over 20 companies. Companies that participated last year included local financial institutions, Best Buy, 1-800-Got-Junk?, Starbucks and Dairy Queen. Participants also always look forward to interviewing for positions open here at the Boys & Girls Clubs of MetroWest as counselors for our summer programs. The Teen Job Fair is another program that aligns with our overall mission to enhance the development of our teens and to prepare them to be responsible and productive members of our communities.
