(Ages 6-9) | Science Week – Explore the world of science and technology! Do LEGO Challenges, build machines, compete in Knowledge Quests! (Architecture, building, design, science basics) |
| Week 2
(Ages 10-14) | Media Week – Produce short films (talk show/game show/newscast/movie), design a news magazine & customize photos! (journalism, media arts, editing, creative writing) |
| Week 3
(Ages 6-9) | Journalism Week – Create & edit media including movies, pictures & magazines! Create a journal, scrapbook or other publication! (journalism, media editing, creative writing) |
| Week 4
(Ages 10-14) | Gaming Week – Design your own video game in RPGMaker and more! Create animations! Compete in challenges! (animation, publishing, media) |
| Week 5
(Ages 6-9) | Music Week – Create and record your own music to take home! Design album art! Write songs! (publishing, media design, broadcasting) |
| Week 6
(Ages 10-14) | Robotics Week – Build and program LEGO Mindstorms EV3 Robots! Compete in design competitions! Explore simple and complex machines! (design, robotics, journalism) |
| Week 7
(Ages 6-9) | Adventure Week – Live & online scavenger hunts, competitions in LEGO Robotics & media arts (drawing, photo editing, etc.) & more! (intro to technology, media, engineering) |
| Week 8
(Ages 10-14) | Invention Week – Create a personal webpage! Design inventions! Introduction to computer programing! Introduction to RPGMaker! (publishing, design, programing) |
