

Wedding Favors for Kids

Congratulations on your engagement & upcoming nuptials! This exciting time is filled with many important decisions on how to make your wedding unique and memorable for your guests. How Wedding Favors for Kids Works:

- Contact BGCMW and let us that know that you are considering the Wedding Favors for Kids program. We will be happy to give you a tour of our Clubs or answer any questions that you might have.
- Decide how much to donate; give a set amount or a per guest dollar amount.
- Make your tax-deductible donation to BGCMW prior to your wedding. We will provide you and you guests with a letter acknowledging your generous donation via mail after your wedding (bride/groom must provide BGCMW with an excel spreadsheet complete with guest names and addresses.)
- BGCMW will acknowledge your thoughtful donation in our e-newsletter (bride and groom can provide engagement or wedding photo to be included in newsletter.)
- Bride & groom will be listed as donor in BGCMW's annual report.

The Impact of Your Donation:

\$1,400 sends a child to summer camp for the entire summer!

\$1000 supports the entire program cost for one child during the school year!

\$700 sends a child to summer camp for half the summer!

\$175 sends a child to summer camp for a full week!

\$25 supports the annual membership fee for one child!
