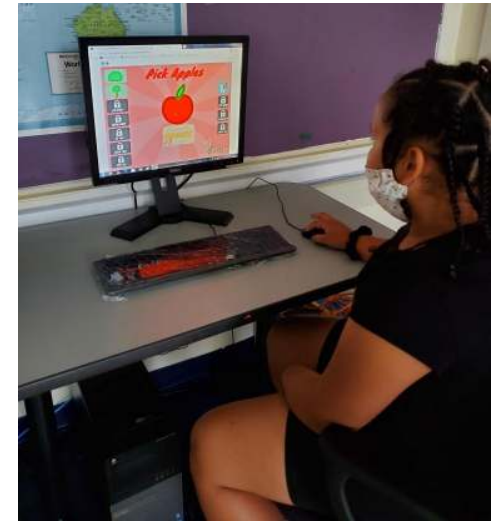
COVID-19 PROTOCOLS
